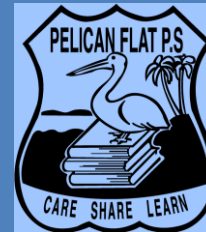

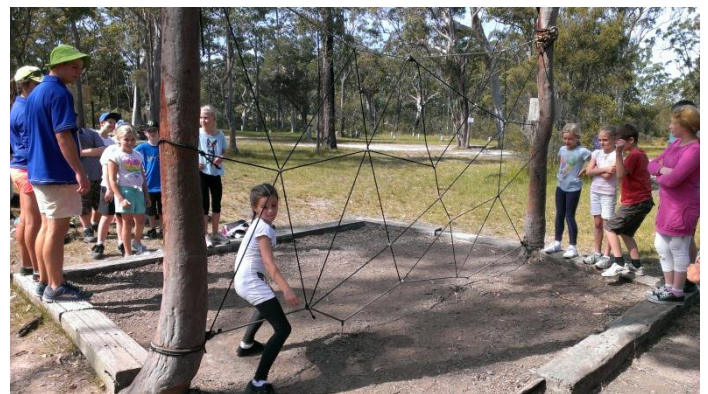
Sport
