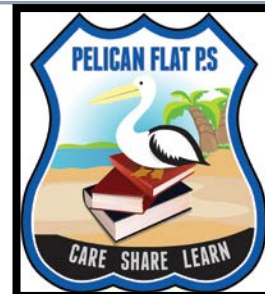

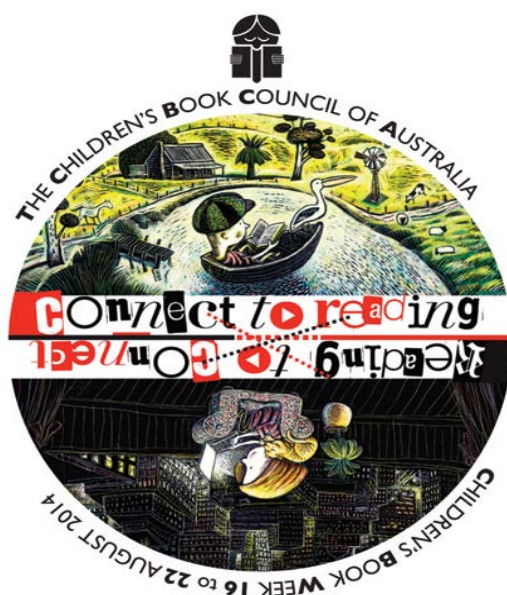
Helmets
